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Colbert Nourrice is a prominent artist of the contemporary Art scene in Seychelles.

Nourrice is inclined towards social analysis. He finds inspiration for his art through relating personal experiences to social and environmental issues which, whilst deriving from the 'small-island state' condition, have global significance.

As a recipient of the third Award in the 5th Biennale of Contemporary Art, Seychelles, 1996, Nourrice has continued to win much individual admiration and public media attention with his paintings which engage themes based on the cycle of human lives heavily occupied with the 'swings and roundabouts' of subsistence and daily life.

He has developed a narrative style utilising signs, symbols and motifs framed to form a striking complexity of linear and cyclical serial images which some observers have found reminiscent of Egyptian or Mayan hieroglyphs.

These bold motifs are often depicted against a background of bright hues splattered with dots and splashes which form a rich, mobile array of rhythmic colour: testimony to the positive dynamics, affirmative vitality and continuing value of Seychelles' créole culture.
